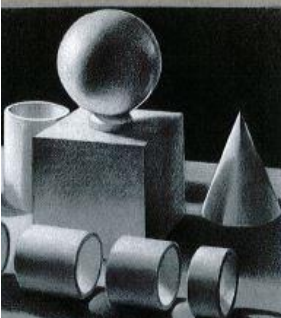

FOUNDATION DRAWING 1

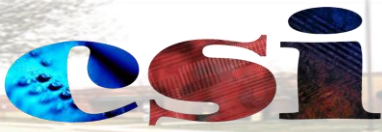
This course is at the undergraduate level and does not assume that the student has any strongly developed drawing skills. Its primary purpose is to introduce the student to basic concepts in drawing and then, develop more creative and expressive responses. Drawing moves the student into a more voluntary understanding of drawing and places considerable emphasis on observational composition and design.

FOUNDATION DRAWING 2

This course follows Drawing 1 as an observational and voluntary approach to drawing. This course expands on these skills and concepts and concentrates on developing more creative and expressive experiences in making art. In it, students explore more advanced problems in drawing with an emphasis on the figure, drawings as a finished work, as well as creative interpretations of assignments.
