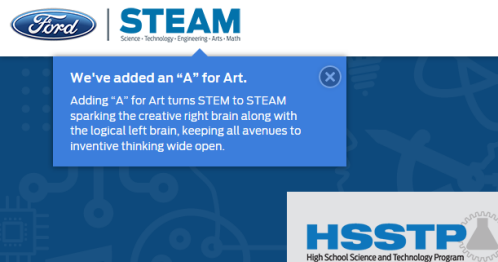
Mr. Feldkamp’s sophomore English classes have been reading *The Crucible*. The students enjoyed bringing the book to life by acting out parts in small groups.
